
## Git process

Previous semester I used GitHub. For me it looked easier to use, but this semester I started using GitLab because of the advice the teachers gave to use it in case something happens to GitHub. I found GitLab more challenging, because I had to use the terminal with all the commands I had to learn.



#### How git manages my workflow

For our group project we want to make an application. And for this to go well and avoid conflicts, we work in a git repository with multiple branches. Each team member on their own branch, like navigation bar, homepage or login page. We merge our files using merge requests in GitLab. By frequently committing with descriptive comments to GitLab it keeps a history of all our changes, with this we can easily undo mistakes. I think this is a nice way of working, you don't work on the same file at the same time, so you don't disturb each other while coding and this keeps our code organized and safe.

I'm trying to get used to using Git, often I face challenges that I have to figure out what it means.


# Challenges I faced

## Problem with switching branches

It deleted the files, and it kept showing this without changing to the other branch. But after trying for a long time, I got know that I have to keep answering no and ultimately it will change to the other branch.

I wanted to merge two files, and the merge got blocked. There were merge conflicts I had to resolve. I could resolve them in Gitlab. I had to choose 'Use ours' or 'Use theirs'. I chose 'Use theirs', because it was the updated version of the code. After this could continue my merge and could also see that the changes were made through the terminal in VScode.

## Merge details

- The source branch is <u>6 commits behind</u> the target branch.
- 27 commits and 1 merge commit will be added to Pronounciation-word-page.
- · Source branch will not be deleted.

I wanted to merge two files again and had to resolve merge conflicts. I couldn't resolve the conflicts via Gitlab but had to do it locally in VScode.

I added the files. Then I made a commit and after this I pushed it to GitLab.
